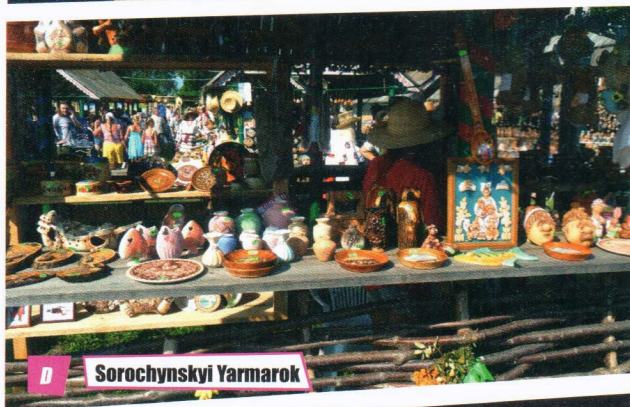
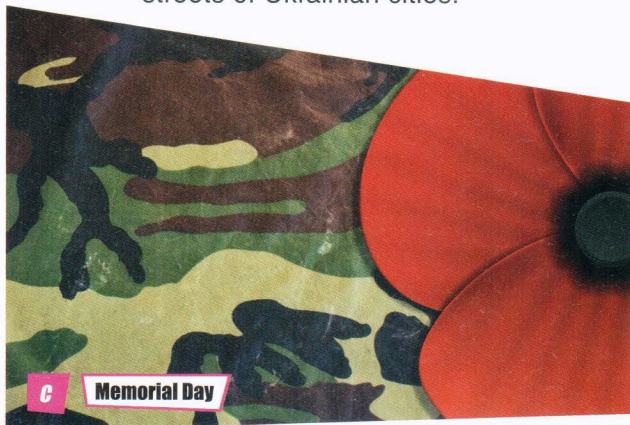

1 **E** This is the international art festival in Ukraine. It takes place in different Ukrainian cities. People come and enjoy theatre plays, musical events, and other performances.
